AED hands out 60 Mother's Newborn Kits to expecting women in a village in West Africa. These kits were assembled by communities in North Georgia.

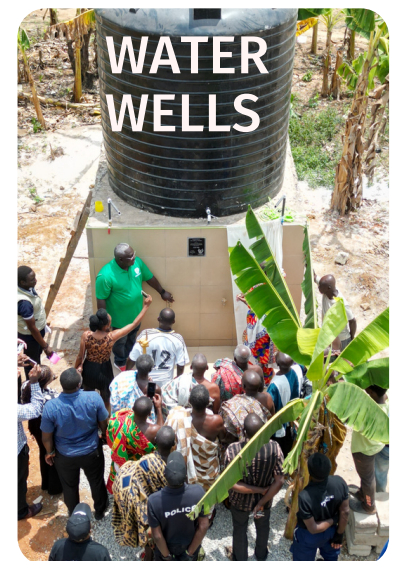


A container of 2.1M gloves was shipped to Ghana in February. These gloves are being used for over a million procedures and examinations.

AED is assembling three more containers to be shipped to Ghana before 2024. Much of the equipment and supplies in these containers were donated by local hospitals and individuals.

The Staheli & Gibson Well was dedicated on March 3rd, 2023 in Akyem-Akropong. The well now gives thousands of people clean water every day.

The well was funded through sponsorships and individual donations to AED.

## THE NUMBERS WE'RE CHANGING

● About 2 million pounds of usable medical supplies are thrown away in large US hospitals as waste every year, while medical facilities in developing countries still lack basic medical supplies.

● With 308 deaths for every 100,000 live births as of 2017, Ghana's maternal mortality rate is very high. Inadequate space and equipment are a large contributing factor.

### HOW WE PROVIDE MEDICAL RESOURCES

AED works with hospitals and individuals to collect unwanted medical supplies (reducing unnecessary medical waste) and ships them to hospitals and clinics in need.

AED partners with local water well drilling companies and works with rural communities to build safe water wells that will service thousands of people.
